## AQUARTUM HUNT: CLOUNFISH

Clownfish or anemone fish are fishes from the subfantly Amphiprioninae in the family Pomacentridae. Thirty species are recognized: one in the genus Premnas, while the remaining are in the genus Amphiprion. In the wild, they all form symbiotic mutualisms with sea anemones. Depending on species, anemone fish are overall yellow, orange, or a reddish or blackish color, and many show white bars or patches. The largest can reach a length of 15–16 cm, while the smallest barely achieve 7–8 cm.
